For most of these students, that's a lot of money. Many of these kids come from troubled homes or areas, or kicked out of school, and they are on their own; they take care/support each other. Some don't even have a home. They are lucky if they get a meal a day. There is one teacher that keeps bread and peanut butter, in her room, for those that can't afford to buy food....it's open to all students. Dispite their problems, most students attend classes regularly, and many come early or stay late, so they can earn credits towards graduation. It's gratifying to see these kids working so hard. SOC's involvement does a lot for these kids. They feel that someone is interested in them and trying to help them. Our Achievement Award is a stroke or a pat on the back to help them along; telling them to keep up the good work, and that we're proud of them. It goes a long ways.
